Additional Requirements	PA-ELR team will provide PA-ELR version of National Standard HL7 2.5.1 Guidelines. Test messages must fully conform to all PADOH/ELR standards and must create complete PA-NEDSS Disease Reports to be considered compliant. All participants are expected to move to full ongoing Production reporting as soon as possible, regardless of stage of MU implementation. Please make sure that the Transport Layer Security is set to TLS Version 1.2 and that TLS 1.0 and TLS 1.1 are disabled. In addition, please make sure that you are connecting through the HL7 Web Service URL and do not have the PA SIIS Web Server IP Address hard coded in your application.
